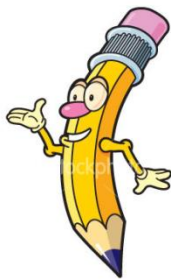


HANDWRITING GROUPS

Handwriting is Complex!



Handwriting incorporates attention, organization, memory, and integration of the sensory-motor

systems. When children encounter frustration with writing, there may be learning or motor components impeding their success. Our handwriting group teaches children how to write incorporating hand-skill development, body awareness, and muscle strengthening, which increases legibility, improves grasp on writing utensil, and promotes confidence.

The Program to Join:

Our handwriting group uses a multi-sensory modalities designed to teach children handwriting in multi-faceted manner. Pre-handwriting skills and letter formation is developed through a series of simple activities, games and exercises. Children are guided to success by building on previous sessions and by using various mediums and adaptations.

What You Can Expect:

Learning to write can be fun when integrating the HEAD, BODY, and HAND! Small groups now forming for ages 4-7 (K-2nd grade)
